Reflections

Joe Bagby

Let me begin by asking you a question. What good thing would you withhold from your children if you believed it would be detrimental to their spiritual development? In other words, do you love your children enough to give them "all things" to ensure for them salvation in Jesus Christ? Since we are asking questions, let me ask you another one. Are there any limits to your generosity and grace when it comes to your children's salvation? Are you willing to go the extra mile, and continue doing so forever in order to benefit those you love the most? If you answered any of these negatively, why is that so? Wouldn't that reflect upon the relationship you have with those who are under your charge?

These questions stand at the heart of Romans 8:32, because here we have a picture of a God who loves mankind so much that he wants *us* to know that he is willing to do whatever is necessary not only to save us, but continue to save us by giving us "all things"! And he has given us a guarantee - seeing that he did not spare his own Son to purchase our redemption. God has given us a blank check for our needs.

But what is it you need? Do you need the strength to overcome a temptation - well, Paul says God will empower you (1 Cor. 10:13). Do you need a friend when all others fail you? John 14 and 15 says Jesus is with you always in the Spirit, and will be with you forever (Matt. 28:20). Do you need instruction on how you should live? Psalm 32 says God will do that. Do you need someone to bear your burdens? Jesus will take them (Matt. 11:28-30). As a matter of fact, the Bible tells us that God will meet all our needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:19).

So, how do *you* respond to such good news (Romans 8:31)?
