"Give a man a fish and you will feed him for a day; teach a man to fish and you will feed him for life."

As a parent I have to remind myself that my job is not simply to supply my children with their immediate needs, but to teach and equip them to meet those needs on their own. It is a difficult challenge, because each time we teach them, we are in essence making them less dependent on us (read: we are working ourselves out of a job!). However, if we never allow them to take responsibility for their actions, to suffer consequences of making mistakes, of learning to motivate themselves to do it on their own, then they will never succeed in life.

As Christians we, too, desire our children to be successful, but we define that differently than the rest of the world. The ultimate goal for our children is not a college degree or a high-paying job . . . what we want more than anything else is that they become true followers of Christ.

In order for that to happen though, we have to allow them to form their own faith. Just like they cannot always depend on Mom or Dad to make dinner, help with homework, or wake them up in the morning, they cannot always expect their spiritual lives to be formed and nurtured by their parents. In John 4 we read of how an entire village had a similar "watershed" moment, and they had to decide if they were going to rely on the faith of others, or develop their own faith. So, how about you? Whose faith do you rely on?
